James Wangerin is retiring April 5, 2010 after 17 years of service.



Retirement Resolution

James R. Wangerin retired from the Department of Natural Resources on April 5th, 2010, with more than 17 years of dedicated and committed Service to the State of Wisconsin and its' Citizens.

Jim began his career with DNR in October of 1992 as a part time clerical Assistant stationed at the Sturgeon Bay office in the Lake Michigan District. His primary duties were to provide clerical support at the Sturgeon Bay office and to assist the Station Manager with Office Administration. Jim was promoted to a Program Assistant-1 in September of 1996 and then reallocated to a Program assistant 2 in the AT/CAER Division in September of 1998. Jim was again reallocated to a Customer Service Representative-Senior classification in Sturgeon Bay in June of 2000. Jim has worked as a Customer Service Representative in the Sturgeon Bay Service Center and remained there until his retirement. His responsibilities were expanded to include license sales, vehicle registration, internal and external customer service as well as management of the Sturgeon Bay office's license accounts.
