

Graduation Before January 1, 2017 – Upon return of both passing homework assignments and the final written test, you will receive a certificate which will serve as your trapping license good through March 31, 2017.

Graduation After January 1, 2017 – Upon return of both passing homework assignments and the final written test, you will receive a certificate which proves you've passed the written part of the Correspondence Course. A Field Test will be required for you to receive your trapping license. As 2017 draws near, look to the DNR website page on Trapper Education for Field Test sites and dates for you to complete the requirements of the Correspondence Course.

Correspondence Course Field Test – The details of the field test, site locations, and dates to be offered are now being drawn up by the WCTEP committee and instructors. Look to the DNR webpage on Trapper Education for specific information mid-2016. The field test itself will be the Authentic Assessments under Appendix B in your Student Manual on pp 181 through 186.

Note from Mike: The cutoff for not having to take the field test will be determined by the postmark on your test envelope. If the postmark is dated 2016, you will receive a trapping license based on passing both homeworks and the written test. If the postmark is 2017, you will be required to pass the field test in addition to the two homeworks and written test.
