

Billing for Title V Sources

- Working on programming and web information for new Title V annual fees (Budget Bill)
- Plan to send email notification to all Title V sources
- Open to suggestions for getting the word out

Notification of Opportunities for 25% ROP & Exemptions

- Total of 809 email notifications to all potentially eligible sources in 3 waves (completed Nov. 25)
- Ted Cauwels, ROP coordinator, has received 17 contacts to date
- Plan to automate notifications & coordinate with emission inventory



Construction Permit Customer Survey

- Construction permit customer surveys
 - What guidance do sources want/need?
 - Where is consistency falling down?
 - How can we improve customer service?
- Summary
 - Response rate = 61%
- Ongoing – as permits are issued




Construction Permit Customer Survey

- Response summary
 - Top guidance topics include air quality analysis modeling; calculating air emissions; MACT applicability; and explaining how long the air permit process takes
 - 60%: consistency in overall air permit process with DNR good or excellent; 32% said fair
 - 50% of respondents willing to be contacted for further feedback

Permit Efficiency Rule

- Scope objective
 - "...to improve operational efficiency and simplify the Air Pollution Permitting processes administered under chs. NR 406 and 407, Wis. Adm. Code, while remaining consistent with the Federal Clean Air Act."*
- Changes to NR 406 – Construction Permits
- Changes to NR 407 – Operation Permits
- Define "Cause or Exacerbate"
- Selected 445 changes concerning S content of diesel during engine testing



Workgroup Member Roles

- Ideas – diversity of view points
- Communication/outreach
- Prioritizing ideas
 - Which rule changes should be included?
 - Which rule changes should we move ahead with now? (first rule package)
 - Which rule changes need more discussion?
 - Of ideas that will need more discussion, where should we put our efforts?



Listening Session Update

- Five listening sessions held in Oct/Nov
- Eau Claire, Mosinee, Milwaukee, Green Bay, and Madison
- Format:
 - Presentation by Department staff
 - Ideas on NR construction and operation permits and “cause or exacerbate”
 - Open proposals from attendees and discussion

Listening Session Update

- Public information
 - Provide better information on public comment and hearing process
 - Provide better outreach to smaller communities and potentially impacted neighbors
 - Concern over where streamlining may be heading



Listening Session Update

- Application process and review
 - Improve application forms
 - Allow for easier electronic submittals
 - Improve permit content, especially plan inclusion
 - Improve consistency in permit documents
 - Always share draft permit with applicants



Listening Session Update

- Pre-permit activities and permit content
 - Allow more construction prior to permit issuance
 - Allow for better incorporation of plans in permits
 - Allow for easier changes to parametric monitoring parameter ranges in permits
 - Make requirements clear and concise



Listening Session Update

- Exemptions and general permits
 - Exempt “like-kind” replacements from NR 406
 - Exempt projects undertaken to comply with federal regulations which have lower emissions or will use a cleaner fuel
 - Improve printer GOPs

Listening Session Update

- Permit renewals and guidance
 - Simplify renewal process
 - Make more permits permanent or have longer (10 year) renewal periods
 - Prioritize renewal based on emissions or compliance status
 - Provide guidance on converting from ROP to traditional permit
 - Improve availability and notice procedures for guidance updates



First Workgroup Meeting

- Madison, November 12 – Combined 406, 407 and Cause or Exacerbate workgroups
- Initial thoughts on priorities:
 - Natural minor exemption
 - Like-kind replacement
 - Commence construction
 - Operation permit expiration
 - Minor revision
 - Adm revision for construction permits
 - Permit integration



First Workgroup Meeting

- Initial ideas – no rule change needed
 - E-forms
 - Permit integration
 - Public process
 - Make public aware of applications
 - Explain public hearing process

Next Steps

- Continue collecting ideas through Dec. 10
- Sort and prioritize
 - What can be done without rule change
 - Which of these changes can we focus on
 - What is outside the scope of the rule
 - Which ideas need rule changes
 - Which of these should we focus on
 - Which should move forward in the first rule package
 - Which should be included in the second rule package



Next Steps

- Send Top 5 to 10 list by January 6, 2014
 - List the top 5 to 10 changes you believe the DNR should move forward with
 - Note which of your top 5 to 10 you believe should go into the first rule package
 - Are there any ideas on the list you believe DNR should *not* pursue
 - DNR will move forward with items considered clean-up and those required by legislation




Schedule

 - Continue work on prioritizing
 - By end of Jan, make final recommendations on first rule package content
- February 2014
 - DNR finalizes prioritization plan for streamlining rule
 - Present final recommendations to full AMMSG

 - Additional workgroup meetings to discuss draft rule language
 - First rule package in board order format
