

File G 2027- Jefferson County 71.36 Acres

The Department acquired this parcel for \$3,309 in 1966. It is a part of the Scattered Wildlife project and is located in the Town of Concord in Jefferson County. The parcel was part of a three parcel purchase to retain as habitat conservation in a heavily farmed area for wildlife use. There is a good quality Oak and Red Maple stand on the parcel.

The parcel is accessible to the public through other Department owned lands to the south via Hwy P, which are also being recommended to be retained. There is high public use on the parcel in fall for deer hunting.

The Department has made investments in the larger wildlife area that include a parking area and property boundary posting work.

The Department recommends retaining this parcel.
