

Parent File G 2518– Jefferson County 10.78 Acres

The Department purchased this parcel for \$450 in 1970. The parcel is a part of the Statewide Scattered Wildlife project and is located in the Town of Waterloo in Jefferson County. It was purchased for its valuable winter cover for upland game and for an access that was needed for adjoining parcels.

The parcel is located within the southeast glacial plains region and has approximately 620 feet of two-bank frontage along Stony Brook Creek. This protected wetland enhances that water body which flows into the Maunesha and Crawfish Rivers, as well as Mud and Chub Lakes.

The Department has not made significant investments in infrastructure or habitat improvements on the property. Minor investments include timber management in the northwest portion of the parcel.

There is heavy public use on the parcel, primarily for hunting and trapping in the fall and winter. The parcel is accessible to the public from an easement that connects to Airport Road.

The Department recommends that the Natural Resources Board retain this parcel.
