

## File G 2528–Jefferson County 1.59 Acres

The Department acquired this parcel for \$450 in 1969 to provide access to Department owned land. The parcel is a part of the Scattered Wildlife project and is located in the Town of Waterloo in Jefferson County.

The parcel was originally acquired to provide access to the parcels to the south; however, it stops at the corner and does not provide legal access. Hunters do use this access in the fall for deer hunting, although these parcels do have an alternate access via an easement from the west via Airport Road. Because the parcels to the south have been recommended for retention, this parcel is also included in that recommendation.

There likely are encroachments from a neighboring farmer to the west.

The Department has not made significant investments in infrastructure or habitat improvements on the property.

The Department recommends retaining this parcel.
