

## Parent File G 3056/Sale File WM 60450–Walworth County 37.09 Acres

The Department acquired this parcel for \$21,500 in 1974. It is a Statewide Extensive Wildlife Habitat parcel and is located in the Town of East Troy in Walworth County. There is approximately 1,600 feet of two bank frontage on an unnamed stream that intersects the property.

The Department has made investments in the parcel, including a firebreak installation and prairie planting (both overgrown), brush management and prescribed burning. However, the property has not been actively managed for many years; more funding would be required to actively manage the property. It is currently overgrown with brush and invasive vegetation.

The main public uses of the property are bow hunting, waterfowl hunting, trapping and rabbit hunting. The parcel is accessible to the public through Hwy L and Stone School Road.

The Department recommends that the Natural Resources Board offer this land for sale under the authority granted by s. 23.145 Wis. Stats.
