

File W 178– Sheboygan County 40.03 Acres


The Department acquired this property for \$32,200 in 1978 for public recreation and pheasant and waterfowl habitat. The property is a part of the Extensive Wildlife Habitat project and is located in the Town of Greenbush in Sheboygan County.

The property is gently rolling and drains towards the wetland in the east half of the property. There is an ephemeral pond and intermittent stream flowing through the wetland on this parcel, which feeds into the Mullet River. It provides habitat for both migratory and breeding waterfowl as well as furbearers, deer and woodcock.

The west half of the parcel has been sharecropped for a number of years; contract expires in 2017. The Department has not made significant investments in infrastructure or habitat on the property.

The public can access the property from CTH U, which runs along the western portion of the parcel and there is an area for parking. The parcel is used by duck, woodcock, turkey and deer hunters.

The Department recommends retaining this parcel.
