

File W 233 - Sheboygan County 127.35 Acres

The Department acquired this parcel for \$58,800 in 1979 from Donald Holzschuh. The parcel is a part of the Extensive Wildlife Habitat project and is located approximately 8 miles west of Plymouth, in the Town of Greenbush in Sheboygan County.

The parcel has approximately 2,645 feet of two bank frontage on the Mullet River. The parcel is located within the Upper Mississippi River and Great Lake Region Joint Venture – Bird Conservation Region 23, which focuses on bird conservation through regionally based, biologically driven, landscape-oriented partnerships.

The Department has made investments in habitat through a Waterfowl Stamp Project that created dense nesting cover by seeding, land work and herbicide. There has also been prescribed burning and boundary posting done on the parcel.

The parcel is accessible to the public from Division Road. Duck hunters use the bridge on Division Road to put boats into the Mullet River to access hunting sites within the property. The parcel is heavily hunted in the fall for deer, waterfowl and woodcock. Grouse has also been found on the parcel.

There may be an encroachment by a neighbor with a deer hunting stand and shooting lanes on the parcel. There is also an upcoming scheduled timber sale for 2018 on the parcel.

The Department recommends retaining this parcel.
