

In order to prevent the movement of invasive forest insects and diseases, firewood burned in Wisconsin DNR campgrounds must originate from within the state and within 25 miles of the campsite in which it will be burned. In addition, firewood that has been harvested, purchased, stored or moved through an Emerald Ash Borer quarantine area may not leave the quarantine area. Firewood from sources approved by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) is allowable.
