15% of the total sale bid value or \$1,000.00, whichever is greater, will be required for performance bond. The cutting area is approximately 176 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree harvest is not allowed.



¹ Mixed Hardwood pulpwood is 44% hard maple, 27% white birch, 23% red maple, 5% basswood, and 1% ironwood. Included is a potential for 35 MBF of sawlogs.

Special Conditions

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
2. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees.
3. Trees may not be felled into wetland/swamp areas.
4. Slash must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.
5. Snowmobile trails must be repaired to pre-harvest condition.
6. Snowmobile trails must be kept free of debris and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times.
7. No harvesting or skidding in Oak stands from April 15 to July 15 due to the risk of oak wilt.
8. Approximately 1.8 miles of new roads may be needed. Some areas are hilly and rocky. Contractor must work with timber sale administrator on road locations. The timber sale map indicates options for potential roads.
9. Harvesting limited to dry or frozen ground only.

Oak Thinning (66 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, white birch, and orange marked trees.

Oak Old-Growth (22 Acres): Cut same as above.

No harvesting or skidding in Oak stands from April 15 - July 15

Northern Hardwood Old-Growth (54 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, and orange marked trees.

Northern Hardwood (29 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, white birch, and orange marked trees.

Balsam Fir OG (5 Acres): Cut all balsam fir.

Note: Do not cut trees marked with green paint.
