Whole tree utilization is not allowed.

<sup>1</sup> Mixed Hardwood - Approximately 42% (199 tons) Aspen, 21% (97 tons) Soft Maple, 20% (94 tons) red oak, 17% (80 tons) White Birch. Included in this volume is approximately 2MBF Soft Maple, 4MBF White Birch saw-log size material.


<sup>2</sup> Balsam Fir - Approximately 69% (48 tons) balsam fir, and 31% (22 tons) white pine.

Special Conditions

1. Seasonal Restriction: Harvesting Activities only allowed from July 15<sup>th</sup> to November 30<sup>th</sup>. Operational period is limited due to oak wilt guidelines applied, and to minimize stem breakage that may occur during the non-growing season.
2. **Skid trails will be designated by sale administrator within the overstory removal block. Damage to developing oak and pine understory must be kept to a minimum and excessive damage will not be tolerated.**
3. Directional felling of trees is required to minimize damage to understory regeneration.
4. Biomass Harvesting is not allowed.
5. All slash is to be lopped and scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale area before being limbed and topped. Trees felled across the blue line must be pulled back into the sale area before being limbed and topped. Trees may not be felled into keg area.
6. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
7. Equipment Restrictions: Skidding of forest product materials will be restricted to shortwood skidders only.
8. Ignore old interior red paint marks; see map for cutting line details.
9. **Note: A portion of this sale is a follow-up removal of large sawlog seed trees. Volume is low, but log values are higher.**

- Overstory Removal Area (27 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, maple, balsam fir and orange marked trees. Take extreme care not to damage oak and pine seedlings.
- Aspen Regeneration Area (7 Acres): Cut same as above plus cut 1 to 5 inch stems except white pine.

July 15th through November 30th**

paint slashes.***
