Special Conditions

- 1. Harvest operations are only allowed in the Hardwood / Oak and Northern Hardwood Thinning areas during very dry or frozen ground conditions to prevent rutting. No harvesting activity allowed in the Northern Hardwood Thinning from April 15 to July 15 to prevent oak wilt. Zone A as shown on the map must be harvested on well-frozen ground only with snow cover to prevent any soil disturbances. Avoid berm or pit features and do not fill pit features with slash.**
2. Cutting must be concurrent for all species including non-merchantable trees where designated.
3. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees.
- 4. Short-wood forwarding only within the Northern Hardwood and Pine Thinning areas.**
5. Slash must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10' behind the tree line along all roads and trails concurrently with cutting.
6. Whole tree utilization or biomass harvesting is not allowed.
7. The snowmobile trail must remain free of debris, snow covered during winter, and left in good condition at all times.
8. All pine products cut between May 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to May 1 of each year.
- 9. The woods road into the Jean Lake boat landing must remain open and in good condition at all times. Access into the Northern Hardwood Thinning will not be allowed from any woods roads to the south.**
10. Dense sapling pockets in the Aspen Mix Area that are 1/10 acre or larger can be avoided during cutting operations with approval from the administering WI DNR forester.



This map is not a survey of the actual boundary of any property this map depicts.

- Aspen Mix Area (371 acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, maple, basswood, ironwood, balsam fir, black spruce, jack pine, and orange marked trees. Cut all 1-5" aspen, white birch, maple, basswood, & ironwood. Do NOT cut any green marked trees. Take extreme care to NOT DAMAGE PINE SAPPLINGS.
- Pine / Aspen Scenic Lakes Area (71 acres): Cut same as Aspen Mix Area but also DO NOT damage any balsam fir, oak, or pine saplings.
- Hardwood / Oak Area (27 acres): Cut same as Aspen Mix Area. Very dry or frozen ground conditions only.
- Pine Thinning (17 acres): Cut same as Aspen Mix Area.
- Northern Hardwood Thinning (44 acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, balsam fir, ironwood, and orange marked trees. Do NOT cut any green marked trees. Very dry or frozen ground conditions only. No harvesting activity allowed between April 15 and July 15 to prevent oak wilt.
