Many lake trout and Chinook salmon have been adipose-clipped to indicate they carry a tiny coded wire tag (CWT) in their snout. A trained technician must find and decode these tags to determine stocking information. This information is important for the future management of Lake Michigan. If you would like to donate the snout from your fish please call one of the DNR field stations listed below and they will give you instructions on how to collect the necessary information and location to drop off the snout.



Trout and salmon with other fin clip patterns can originate from other states, and would be considered “strays” in Wisconsin waters. Fin regeneration makes some clips difficult to see. Note: These are not total numbers of trout and salmon stocked, only those that have been fin clipped. For non-specific locations listed in the summary please see the latest Wisconsin’s Lake Michigan Salmonid Stocking Summary (PUB-FH-828 2012).
