


Richard Bong State Recreation Area Special Use Area / Dog Training Map

-  Class 1 Grounds (Horses Permitted)
-  Class 2 Grounds (Closed to All Training April 15-July 31)

SPECIAL USE ZONE / DOG TRAINING AND TRIAL GROUNDS (Class 1 & 2)

- No training or trials involving the use of birds or weapons of any type (including blank or starter guns) is allowed outside the Special Use Zone trial/training grounds.
See map on reverse side.
- Department of Natural Resources dog training/trial license are required if game birds or firearms are used (except starting pistols). **A license is needed for each person that handles the gun, the dog, or the game birds.** Licenses can be purchased at RBSRA park offices or DNR service centers.
- Purchase of a training license implies acceptance of the rules and regulation as stated in the WI Dog Training and Trial regulations, as well as rules regulating the use of Wisconsin state parks and forests.
- **All vehicles entering the park require a Wisconsin state park admission sticker available at park offices. When offices are closed, self registration is required.**
- Dog training is prohibited on the grounds when a DNR sanctioned trial or other event is occurring. **Please call ahead to check if areas for individual training are available.**
- **Please stop at the office when entering the park to check on areas available for training.**
- All dogs must be leashed during nesting season, April 15 through July 31, except in the Class 1 grounds, the on-foot training areas or during trials. Leashed dogs must be hand held at all times and under control.
- During pheasant hunting season, mid October through December 31, dog training hours are restricted to after 3PM. Trainers may not enter the training area until after 3PM.
- Dog training on horseback is allowed in Class I training grounds only, conditions permitting.
- All motor vehicles are restricted to paved roads and parking lots, unless prior written approval is received from park offices for service road access-conditions permitting. Check signs at service roads for accessibility status.
- All birds used in training must be obtained from a licensed game farm. Receipts for birds must be carried “on person” and shown to a Ranger upon request. All captive, wild birds must be banded with a DNR leg band prior to release. DNR leg bands may be obtained when purchasing a dog training license.
- The field trial/training grounds is a “carry in – carry out” area. Spent birds, crates, refuse, spent shells, and plastic ribbon markers *must be* removed from the grounds after training or trials are completed. Pick up and dispose of all dog feces on shelter grounds and parking lot.
- No cutting of grounds vegetation is permitted unless pre-authorized by the park superintendent.
- No overnight camping is allowed on the grounds unless part of a DNR sanctioned event and all fees are paid. Special rules apply. Contact the park office.
- **Richard Bong’s Special Use Zone is a multi-use area. Be prepared to share the area with other park users.**
