

Wisconsin DNR - Hunter Education Internet Field Day Courses



An optional method of certification for those that prefer a faster pace is the Internet Course Field Day. All ages are welcome to participate in this course however please understand that students will need to read, comprehend and retain information before attending the Internet Course Field Day and then readily apply it at the Internet Course Field Day. Students that attend the Internet Course Field Day will need to pass the hands-on field test and written exam to obtain certification.

The course consists of two parts, part one is the Internet Course only available via internet at the IHEA.com website and part two is the Volunteer Hunter Safety Instructor led Internet Field Day.

The Internet Course: You will need to complete the Internet Course before attending the Internet Course Field Day. The Internet Course takes an average student about 7-10 hours to complete. The Internet Course www.IHEA.com is a great way to read, review and learn about Hunter Safety. Students can take the Internet Course and its quizzes as many times as they want, whenever they want and it is FREE. Even if you choose not to attend an Internet Course Field Day, you can still use the Internet Course to learn about Hunter Safety. Again this is a FREE resource and is a great way to learn about Hunter Safety.

The Internet Field Day: is the Volunteer Hunter Safety Instructor led hands-on portion of the course. You are required to participate in the hands-on portion which also includes shooting a firearm. You will need to take a written exam, a field test and pass both to become certified. Internet Course Field Days are usually held on Saturdays; a \$10 registration fee applies, the course will last about 8 hours.

Before getting started, obtain your own Wisconsin DNR Customer ID Number. You can do this by calling the Wisconsin DNR Customer Service Number at 1-888-936-7463 available 7am-10pm daily. Then check for any available Internet Field Day classes by searching the Wisconsin DNR Website for keyword: **Upcoming Safety Classes** or clicking on <https://hfwolf.centraltechnology.net/wdnr/laam.nsf/publicHSClasses?OpenForm>

Please understand that our Hunter Education Courses are provided by Volunteer Instructors and therefore subject to volunteer availability and other personal commitments. You can check to see if an Internet Field Day Course is being offered near you by visiting the Upcoming Safety Classes link daily and scrolling to find the course that you wish to attend. Check often and sign up soon. When you find the course you wish to attend contact the listed Volunteer Instructor to register ASAP. The cost to attend the Internet Field Day is \$10 per student.

Here are the steps again; that you will need to follow if you are interested in attending an "Internet Field Day Course":

1. Obtain a DNR Customer ID Number by calling the Customer Service Number at 1-888-936-7463 available 7am-10pm daily.
2. Find an Internet Field Day Course listed on the Upcoming Courses page and contact the Volunteer Instructor to get registered.
3. Complete the Internet Course at www.IHEA.com and bring the printed out quizzes from the IHEA Internet Course with you to the Internet Course Field Day. The quizzes the required pre-requisite to attend and will be collected when you arrive at the Internet Course Field Day. Your Volunteer Instructor will give specific instructions regarding this and other things when you register.

* At the Internet Course Field Day you will take two exams; one field test and one written.

* Upon successful completion of the Internet Course Field Day and both exams, you will be issued a temporary Hunter Education Safety Certificate. You should receive the wallet sized Hunter Education Safety Certificate from the Department within 3-4 weeks of successful completion of the course.
